Eye Contact	User	Transient superficial irritation	Low risk because we use it diluted in water	Rinse thoroughly with plenty of water for several minutes. If symptoms persist, seek medical advice.
Skin Contact	User	Prolonged exposure may cause skin irritation	Low risk because we squeeze the bottle and do not come into contact with the substance	Rinse affected area with water. If needed apply cold compress to relieve irritation. If symptoms persist, discontinue use of product and seek medical advice

Ingestion	User	Possible mild gastro-intestinal irritation with nausea and vomiting	Low	<p>Drink water to dilute product. Do not induce vomiting. Act immediately in order to prevent further irritation of mouth, throat and stomach mucosa. If symptoms persist, if persistent vomiting occurs or if blood tinged vomit is present, seek medical advice.</p>
Inhalation	User	Inhaling aerosolized product may cause mild irritation of the respiratory systems	Low	<p>Go to open air and ventilate suspected area. If irritation is experienced, mouth and throat may be rinsed with water. Aerosolized product adhering to the nasal cavity may be rinsed / diluted with saline / plain water. If irritation or asthma-like symptoms persist, seek medical advice.</p>
